Re: Conflict Minerals – RESPONSE REQUIRED

Dear Valued Supplier,

As a result of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act and the Conflict Minerals rules recently adopted by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (the “SEC”), many companies, including certain of our customers, are required to make disclosures regarding whether “conflict minerals” used to manufacture their products originated in the Democratic Republic of Congo (“DRC”) or the adjoining countries (as defined on the attached Exhibit A) (collectively, together with the DRC, the “Covered Countries”). These “conflict minerals” consist of columbite-tantalite, cassiterite, **gold**, wolframite, or their derivatives, which are initially limited to **tantalum, tin, and tungsten** (collectively, the “Conflict Minerals”).

Farwest Steel Corporation (including its subsidiaries, “Farwest”) will not purchase material that is that is not “DRC conflict free” (as defined by the applicable SEC rules), from you or any other supplier. We require that all material you supply to Farwest be “DRC conflict free” and request your formal confirmation that all material supplied by your company is and will be “DRC conflict free.”

To remain one of our suppliers, please countersign this letter and return it to me to confirm as indicated below that all material you supply is “DRC conflict free.” If you are not able to make such confirmation, please contact me immediately.



**EXHIBIT A
COVERED COUNTRIES**

The “Covered Countries” are the Democratic Republic of Congo (“DRC”) and the “adjoining countries.”

An “adjoining country” is a country that shares an internationally recognized border with the DRC, which presently includes Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, the Republic of the Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, and Zambia.
